New restaurants open in Sugar Land Town Square

Visitors to Sugar Land Town Square will soon have three new dining options.

Escalante's and Swirll Frozen Yogurt have just opened for business, while Taisho, a Japanese Hibachi grill, is scheduled to open on the first floor of the new Minute Maid headquarters building.

Escalante's, located at 15933 City Walk, offers Mexican and Tex-Mex food in a casual atmosphere. The restaurant also offers catering services.

This location marks Escalante's fifth Houston-area location.

Next door to Escalante's, Swirll serves frozen yogurt and smoothies in 16 flavors, along with fresh fruits and various toppings. Located at 15955 City Walk, this store represents the fourth Swirll in the Houston area.

Taisho, scheduled to open in July, will bring Japanese cuisine to Sugar Land. The restaurant will offer Japanese Hibachi, Yakitori, Tapioca cream tea and traditional Japanese kitchen food. The opening will mark Taisho's sixth Houston-area location.

The openings come on the heels of many other happenings in Town Square, including the recent relocation of Minute Maid's corporate headquarters to a newly completed office building in the development.
