How To Enter

Attend the Live Audition on **Wednesday, March 20th** in the lobby of 2277 Plaza Drive at Sugar Land Town Square. Registration starts at 5:15 pm and auditions will take place from 5:30-7:30 pm. Entrants must sing a cappella, without musical accompaniment and should be prepared to sing for 60-90 seconds. All Entrants will receive a number and will be asked to audition in numerical order.

Screening Process

A panel of judges will hear all auditions and will narrow down entries to approximately 15, who will be contacted by phone and/or email to verify residency. Applicants will complete a preliminary interview. If Applicant is chosen as a Contestant, he/she will be assigned a performance time at the finale.

Competition

1. A panel of judges will evaluate Contestant performances during the competition and will select *approximately* 15 finalists.
2. The Finalists will compete for the title of Jr. Sugar Land Superstar on April 27th.
3. The opinions and decisions of the judges are final.
