



Because the turf is not regenerated like natural grass, anything left on the turf remains there, posing health and safety hazards as well as general degradation of the turf.

To preserve the quality of the turf and provide a clean and healthy environment, the following are prohibited:

- Stakes, spikes or other pointed objects, including stiletto-type heels.
- Dragging of equipment. All equipment must be lifted when moved or have turf wheels attached.
- No individual leg furniture is permitted without a flat base on the bottom. This goes for tents, chairs, etc. If there is not a base to the legs, please make sure that you provide something such as Masonite or wood to place underneath so it does not puncture.
- Sharp objects such as tent stakes or corner flags
- Unauthorized vehicles, bicycles, scooters, skateboards or in-line skating
- RC cars, planes or toys that use fuel
- Lighter fluid or other gasoline type products/propane tanks
- Open flames including grills, portable heaters
- Glass bottles or containers of any type
- Suntan lotions, oils or creams of any kind - Please apply sunblock prior to entering the turf area
- Painting, chalking, tape or other adhesive material without prior approval
- Smoking or tobacco products of any kind
- Sunflower seeds and gum

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE CANCELANATION OF PLAZA RESERVATION.

TURF USER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Clean Up

1. You are responsible for leaving the turf clean and ready for the next user. When you are done, please inspect the area and remove anything leftover from your event or spectators.
2. Cleaning spills and participant fluids: Spills of foreign substances should be removed as quickly as possible. Thoroughly rinse any cleaning attempts to avoid slippery areas that could result in injury. Contact the Property Management Office at 281-276-6000 for assistance if needed.
3. In the event that a user leaves the turf without being cleaned and/or damaged, the minimum cleaning fee will be \$100 and shall represent actual expenses incurred for repair and/or replacement.
4. Please notify the on-site Event Manager if any areas of the turf are damaged or deficient.
